Actualization of Rights

The Community Services Administration operates centers for rights actualization. Their goal is to assist Jerusalem residents in implementing their rights. The service is available to the entire population, including: Single-parent families, new immigrants, people with disabilities, the senior population and more.

Centers for rights actualization, available throughout the city, provide services in the following areas:

-  Actualization of rights within various institutions such as The National Insurance Institute
-  Actualization of rights in various fields such as housing, debts, consumerism, employees' rights, etc
-  Advocacy and activism aimed at influencing and changing policy and procedures
-  Raising social awareness and calling attention to specific issues on the public agenda

Promoting Employment and Entrepreneurship

The Community Services Administration offers Jerusalem's residents assistance with expanding employment opportunities, and ensuring quality work placements. Guidance for development of business entrepreneurship is also available. Target populations include: All residents of working age who want to improve their employment and economic status as well as those interested in developing a business or expanding an existing business. Examples of programs offered in the past year include:

-  Vehicular safety inspector course
-  Training for child care workers
-  Daycare center management course
-  Workshops for business owners
-  Business entrepreneurship course and financial planning for orthodox women
-  Preparation to enter the work force for different populations in East Jerusalem: Hebrew courses; occupational empowerment; etc.
-  Coaching to improve occupational prospects
-  Integration into the work force for aged 45+
